Tasting Note

**BABICH MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC 2010**



**Grapes:**

100% Sauvignon Blanc

**Region:**

Marlborough

**Winemaker:**

Adam Hazeldine

**Production Notes:**

After harvest the grapes were quickly crushed and pressed into stainless steel tanks where the juice was fermented at controlled cool temperatures to capture the intense varietal flavours. After extensive tasting trails by the winemakers the wine was blended, finished and bottled.

**Tasting Notes:**

Musk melon, lime and an intriguing minerality dominate the nose. The entry is all upfront fruit salad, with extra lashings of pear and some kiwifruit. Fresh and juicy fruit, with nettle and herbal notes take the mid palate to the finish to join agreeably with guava and lime. A very well balanced wine with a lovely medium weight.

**Recommended Food:**

Screams out for seafood (think fresh oysters)!

**Recommended Cellaring:**

Best enjoyed while young.
