Viticulture and Wine Making	All Carrick Rieslings are hand harvested, and picked early to preserve the powerful floral aromatics and bright citrus acidity which are characteristic of Central Otago. The grapes for this wine come solely from our Lot 8 block. The wine has been whole bunch pressed and fermented with wild yeast. The gentle handling of this wine means that it has been bottled without fining.		
Tasting Notes	A lively nose packed with oranges, honeysuckle and soft jasmine aromatics . The palate is bright and fresh with juicy oranges and lush apricots. The mouthwatering acidity is balanced with concentrated sweet fruit and the steely minerality gives the wine good focus. This is a delicately poised wine with a vibrant fruit and honeysuckle finish.		
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
