Brilliantly clear straw yellow in colour, this has a gentle nose of gooseberries, fennel, savoury herbs, citrus fruits and minerals. A dry, elegant wine the fruit expression is restrained and relatively subtle for this variety. There is still excellent freshness and liveliness, and the laid back nature enables accessibility and drinkability. Fruit from the organically certified 5 ha 'Headwaters' block in the Wairau Valley. Cool fermented to 12.0% alc. in stainless-steel. A stylish wine to enjoy over the next two years as an aperitif and with shellfish."
