colour Pale straw with lime green hints

nose A classic rich Chardonnay nose with aromas of ripe stone fruits and poached pears combined with hints of biscuit and toasted almonds from barrel maturation.

palate A warm rich palate with luscious stone fruit flavours, great texture and power, yet finishes clean and crisp. A well balanced and elegant wine.

general

Mount Maude is a small vineyard owned by Dawn and Terry Wilson in the beautiful Maungawera Valley near Wanaka, New Zealand. Planted in 1994 on a steep, north-facing terraced slope, terrior of this vineyard combined with the long dry autumns we experience in Central Otago provide perfect growing conditions for our grapes.

Our 2010 Chardonnay was hand harvested, whole bunched pressed through our basket press and fermented in new and seasoned French oak puncheons. Minimal movement or fining to ensure the pure and delicate aromas of this wine from a great vineyard and year were protected.
