A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Sangiovese, this is beautifully complex on the nose showing aromas of dark cherry, cocoa, game and cedary oak. The palate is concentrated, yet not heavy, with fine texture and refreshing acidity leading to a firm dry finish. A multi-layered and stylish red, designed to partner flavoursome meaty dishes, although it would be equally satisfying to have it with hard cheese and roasted almonds. At its best: now to 2016.
