Dick Frizzell is a famous New Zealand artist who has designed a set of quirky labels. Rumour has it that his wine cartons were trading for a considerable sum. With such an emphasis on packaging it is easy to assume that the wine quality might not be up to scratch. That is certainly not the case. This is a ripe, rich and fleshy wine with intense dark berry, chocolate and mixed spice flavours. Very impressive red from a top vintage.

Medium-deep red/purple in colour, this is a gloriously rich and opulent red displaying blackberry, dark plum and a hint of dried herb characters. The palate is powerful and dense with silky texture and a lingering dry finish. It's plump, fleshy and simply delicious. By the way, this wine has one of the most striking labels I've seen - the words of haka are written in shiny black on a charcoal black background. At its best: now to 2014. 14.5% Screw cap.
