



## Tasting Note

*From South Australia, Baritone captures the big flavours and robust style on which Australian red wines have built their enormous popularity. This traditionally styled, big bold beauty has lashings of flavour and represents exceptional value in a large 1000ml bottle.*

**Colour:** Deep ruby red with dark purple hues.

**Bouquet:** Blending of the two varieties produces a wine displaying the attractive aromas of liquorice, spice and dark berries supplemented with soft cedar oak.

**Palate:** The full-bodied palate shows blackberry and blackcurrant fruit with a firm tannin structure. The oak flavour lingers on for a long fine finish.

**Cellar:** 6+yrs

**Foods:** Barbecued steak, char-grilled ribs, garlic sausages.
