Top of the class was the Frizzell Methode Traditionelle Brut NV. It is made from the three classic champagne grape varieties and has everything you want in a fizz.

Simply the best fizz in the tasting. The labels on the Frizzell bottles may draw a good deal of attention given their creator but this should not detract from the regularly excellent wines contained within. Rod McDonald is the winemaker and this is definitely a partnership going places. The earthy tones on the nose are followed by peaches, baked apples and brioche in the palate - all in a creamy mousse that provides complexity and great length. The perfect celebration drink.
