



Lustau Almacenista Oloroso Pata de Gallina 1/38 Jarana

Description:

Dark gold in colour, with aromas of dried fruits. Very rich and concentrated with a powerful intensity on the palate, found in the oldest soleras of Oloroso sheries. Awarded Bronze Medal at the IWC 2004.



When To Drink it:

Either as an apéritif with toasted almonds or olives, or to accompany rich game dishes, or with the cheeseboard.

How To Serve it:

Serve at cool room temperature.
