Neudorf Pinot Noir Rose 2011

Pink but not girly.

Rose is a joy – a wine to celebrate. It simply says summer, warmth and friends.

Neudorf Rose is created from Pinot Noir left on the skins for just a few hours.

Cranberry and plums with hints of strawberry candy on the nose leading through to a minerally finish with a hint of mandarin zest.

It is full and creamy on the palate. This chic wine is great with smoked salmon, runny Brie and alongside anything at Christmas.

Technical Notes

Pristine first crop Pinot Noir grapes from Flaxmore Vineyard were hand harvested for the Rose. The fruit was destemmed and soaked overnight prior to pressing. The analysis at harvest was 23.2 Brix, 3.58pH and 6g/L TA.

Also portions of juice were bled off from Pinot Noir ferments and fermented separately. The fermentation was controlled to give an even fermentation rate to a dry style and the wine was left on yeast lees briefly prior to stabilising. The wine was stabilised for heat and cold, filtered and bottled early on 9/8/2011.

Analysis at Bottling 3.51pH, 5.5g/L Total Acidity, 5.1g/L RS, and 13.5%v/v Alcohol.
