Elegant Chardonnay with a core of grapefruit/fig fruit flavours that's been artfully seasoned with delicately nutty yeast lees and spicy oak flavours. The fruit slightly dominates. This is a dry and satisfyingly complex wine with energy and drive.

For a young wine this is beautifully harmonised and great drinking. The nose is nicely fragrant displaying peach, citrus and gently infused creamy oak characters. It's rounded and smooth on the palate with excellent weight and a lingering delicious finish.

Made from certified organic grapes from Seresin's 'Home' and 'Raupo Creek' vineyards, indigenous yeast fermented to 13.5% alc., in seasoned French barriques, and matured 11 months in oak. Bright pale straw-yellow colour with some green hues, this has a full, rich nose of ripe citrus and tropical fruits with noticeable buttery malolactic elements and herb nuances. A richly flavoured wine on palate with lush citrus and tropical fruit flavours, there is a significant MLF buttery component with oak toastiness, very well balanced and integrated showing in an up-front and accessible style. Fine textures provide some dryness and the wine finishes crisply. This is an approachable and harmonious Chardonnay that will match poultry and pork well over the next 3-4 years.
