BABICH LONE TREE HAWKE'S BAY SAUVIGNON BLANC 2010



Grapes:

100% Sauvignon Blanc

Region:

Hawke's Bay

Winemaker:

Production Notes:

The grapes were crushed and pressed at our Auckland winery upon arrival. To enhance the varietal flavour expression, fermentation took place in refrigerated stainless steel tanks at cool temperatures using a variety of yeasts. After 2 months on lees the blend was assembled and bottled.

Tasting Notes:

The aroma is gooseberry and cut grass with underlying tropical fruits. The palate is soft, mouthfilling and juicy - good fruit intensity with red apples and melon standing out. Well-balanced acidity and herbal combine to make this a delightfully refreshing wine.

Recommended Food:

It makes a nice partner for a summery ham salad, or a smoked salmon frittata.
