Red Knot is the second label of Shingleback, an excellent McLaren Vale producer, and the price of this wine is scarcely believable. It has a sweet, confectionery-like grenache aroma that's ripe and delicious and faintly herbal. In the mouth it's intense and concentrated, sweetly succulent, soft and rounded, with very mild, gentle tannins. There is focus and elegance about this wine and it hasn't fallen prey to overripeness or excessive alcohol. It's a thoroughly slurpable, easy-to-enjoy kind of wine that deserves to be more popular. It's almost a warm-climate alternative to pinot noir.
