An impressive, complex and deeply structured Pinot that has a wealth of ripe dark cherry fruit on the nose an array of fine ground baking spices some sappy bracken and fragrant elevated perfume. The palate's got that engaging pinot thing going on where it's dense yet fine; generous ripe red cherry and plum flavours roll through and some chocolate and spice, supple tannins and convincing presence here.
